### PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE

## STATE BOARD OF ARCHITECTURE, INTERIOR DESIGN

### AND RESIDENTIAL DESIGN

#### LCB File No. R045-11

August 31, 2011

EXPLANATION - Matter in *italics* is new; matter in brackets [omitted material] is material to be omitted.

AUTHORITY: §§1-17, section 2 of Senate Bill No. 268, chapter 529, Statutes of Nevada 2011, at page 3678.

- A REGULATION relating to architects; providing for the issuance and renewal of certificates of eligibility to receive certain preferences when competing for public works; establishing fees for the issuance and renewal of certificates of eligibility to receive certain preferences when competing for public works; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.
- **Section 1.** Chapter 623 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto the provisions set forth as sections 2 to 16, inclusive, of this regulation.
- Sec. 2. As used in sections 2 to 16, inclusive, of this regulation, unless the context otherwise requires, the words and terms defined in sections 3 to 6, inclusive, of this regulation have the meanings ascribed to them in those sections.
- Sec. 3. "Affidavit for a certificate of eligibility" means an affidavit from a certified public accountant required pursuant to subsection 1 of section 2 of Senate Bill No. 268, chapter 529, Statutes of Nevada 2011, at page 3678.

- Sec. 4. "Affidavit for renewal of a certificate of eligibility" means an affidavit from a certified public accountant required pursuant to subsection 5 of section 2 of Senate Bill No. 268, chapter 529, Statutes of Nevada 2011, at page 3678.
- Sec. 5. "Certificate of eligibility" means a certificate of eligibility to receive a preference when competing for public works issued by the Board to an architect pursuant to section 2 of Senate Bill No. 268, chapter 529, Statutes of Nevada 2011, at page 3678.
- Sec. 6. "Statement of compliance" means a statement from an architect who applies for a certificate of eligibility which states that the architect is properly registered as an architect pursuant to the provisions of chapter 623 of NRS for the certificate of eligibility for which he or she is applying.
- Sec. 7. 1. An architect who wishes to obtain a certificate of eligibility must submit to the Board:
  - (a) An application on a form provided by the Board;
  - (b) A notarized affidavit for a certificate of eligibility on a form provided by the Board;
  - (c) A notarized statement of compliance on a form provided by the Board;
  - (d) The fee set forth in NAC 623.290; and
  - (e) Any other documentation required by the Board.
- 2. If two or more architectural firms wish to combine in any legal form for the purpose of submitting a proposal on a public work or a project for the construction, reconstruction or improvement of a highway for which the combined entity will seek a preference pursuant to NRS 338.1711 to 338.1727, inclusive, 408.3875 to 408.3887, inclusive, or 625.530, the entity resulting from the combination is not eligible for the applicable preference unless each firm

entering into the combination employs an architect who holds, or applies and qualifies for, a certificate of eligibility.

- Sec. 8. 1. An application for a certificate of eligibility must include, without limitation:
- (a) The name of the applicant;
- (b) The certificate number of the applicant;
- (c) The mailing address of the applicant;
- (d) The telephone number of the applicant;
- (e) The signature of the applicant; and
- (f) Any other information that the Board may require.
- 2. An affidavit for a certificate of eligibility must:
- (a) Be on a form provided by the Board;
- (b) Be notarized; and
- (c) Include a certificate by a certified public accountant that the applicant meets the requirements of section 2 of Senate Bill No. 268, chapter 529, Statutes of Nevada 2011, at page 3678.
- Sec. 9. The Board or its designee will issue or deny a certificate of eligibility within a reasonable time after the date on which the Board receives the application, all required documentation that supports the application and the fee set forth in NAC 623.290.
  - **Sec. 10.** The certificate of eligibility must include, without limitation:
  - 1. The date of issuance;
  - 2. The date of expiration;

- 3. The name and certificate number of the architect to whom the certificate of eligibility is issued; and
  - 4. Such other information as the Board deems appropriate.
- Sec. 11. The Board will issue a duplicate certificate of eligibility to any architect who has received a certificate of eligibility, who certifies that his or her certificate of eligibility has been lost or destroyed and who pays the fee set forth in NAC 623.290.
- Sec. 12. An affidavit for renewal of a certificate of eligibility must be on a form provided by the Board and must be notarized.
- Sec. 13. The Board will not issue a certificate of eligibility to an architect whose certificate of registration is not on active status. If an architect whose certificate of registration is not on active status has received a certificate of eligibility, the Board will revoke the certificate of eligibility. Such an architect must reapply for a certificate of eligibility pursuant to subsection 1 of section 2 of Senate Bill No. 268, chapter 529, Statutes of Nevada 2011, at page 3678, and sections 2 to 16, inclusive, of this regulation.
- Sec. 14. 1. If an architect who applies to the Board for a certificate of eligibility submits false or misleading information, submits an application which is incomplete or does not comply with this chapter or chapter 338 of NRS, the Board may:
  - (a) Deny the application;
- (b) If the architect has received a certificate of eligibility, revoke the certificate of eligibility; or
  - (c) Take such action as the Board deems appropriate under the circumstances.

- 2. In carrying out the provisions of this section, the Board may rely on information contained in the records maintained by the Board and need not conduct any investigation, inquiry or hearing regarding the information contained in those records.
- Sec. 15. If a written objection is filed with a public body pursuant to subsection 10 of section 2 of Senate Bill No. 268, chapter 529, Statutes of Nevada 2011, at page 3678, the Board or its designee will, upon request by the public body, provide to the public body a copy of the application of the architect against whom the complaint was made and any documentation submitted with the application.
- Sec. 16. 1. If a public body determines that a written objection is accompanied by the required proof or substantiating evidence pursuant to subsection 11 of section 2 of Senate Bill No. 268, chapter 529, Statutes of Nevada 2011, at page 3678, the public body must notify the Board in writing of the determination of the public body within 30 days after the date of its determination.
- 2. Upon receipt of the written documentation from the public body, the Board or its designee will immediately revoke the certificate of eligibility for the architect. No formal disciplinary hearing is required before revocation of the certificate of eligibility based upon the receipt of the documentation from the public body which received the proposal on a contract for the completion of a public work.
  - **Sec. 17.** NAC 623.290 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 623.290 1. The following fees are prescribed and will be collected by the Board at the time an application is made or material is furnished:

# (a) For an examination for a certificate:

(1) For the examination for registration as a residential designer if the entire	
examination is taken at one time	\$300
(2) If the entire examination is not taken at one time:	
(I) For the graphic section of the examination for registration as a	
residential designer	150
(II) For each written section of the examination for registration as a	
residential designer	75
(3) For the written examination for registration as a registered interior designer	100
(4) By reciprocity or other means requiring special action by the Board	300
(5) For the computer architect registration examination, in addition to the regular	
fee for examination	50
(b) For a certificate of registration	125
(c) For the late renewal of an expired certificate of registration within 1 year after	
its expiration	220
(d) For the late renewal of a certificate which has been expired for more than 1 year	
but not more than 3 years	300
(e) Except as otherwise provided in paragraph (f), for an initial registration or a	
renewal of a registration	150
(f) For an initial registration issued in November or December	75
(g) For restoration of an expired or revoked certificate of registration	300

(h) For replacement of a certificate of registration	30
(i) For application forms	25
(j) For the issuance of a certificate of eligibility to an architect pursuant to	
sections 2 to 16, inclusive, of this regulation	300
(k) For the renewal of a certificate of eligibility issued to an architect pursuant to	
sections 2 to 16, inclusive, of this regulation	. 125
(l) For the issuance of a duplicate certificate of registration to an architect	
pursuant to section 11 of this regulation	30
2. The Board will, upon request, make available the schedule of fees charged by the	
National Council of Architectural Registration Boards for the examination for registration as	an
architect and for retaking any part or parts of the examination.
